1775-1851

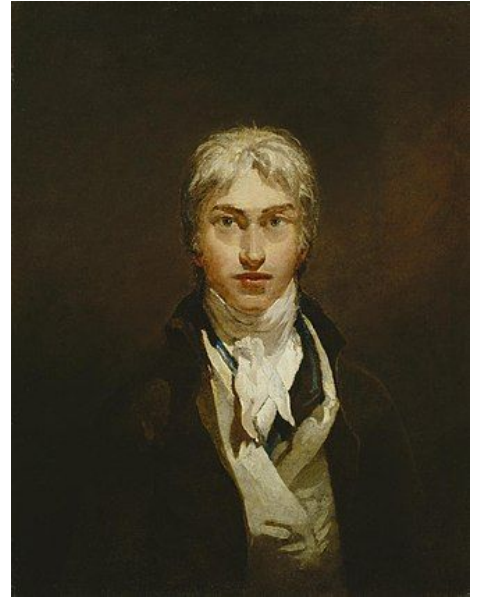
Lower middle-class London, child prodigy

1840-1926

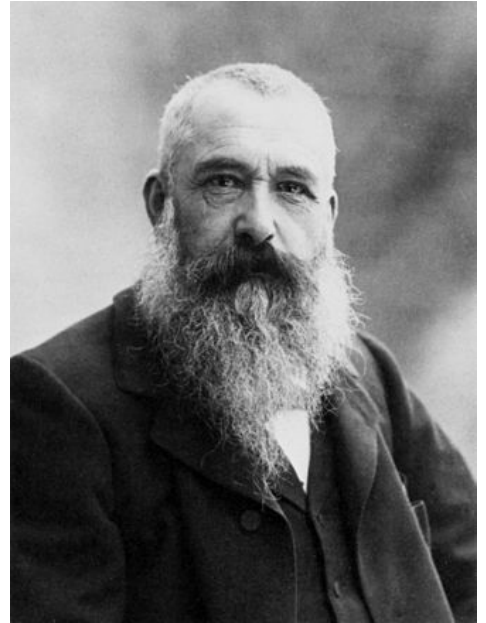
Parisian Catholic, later atheistic

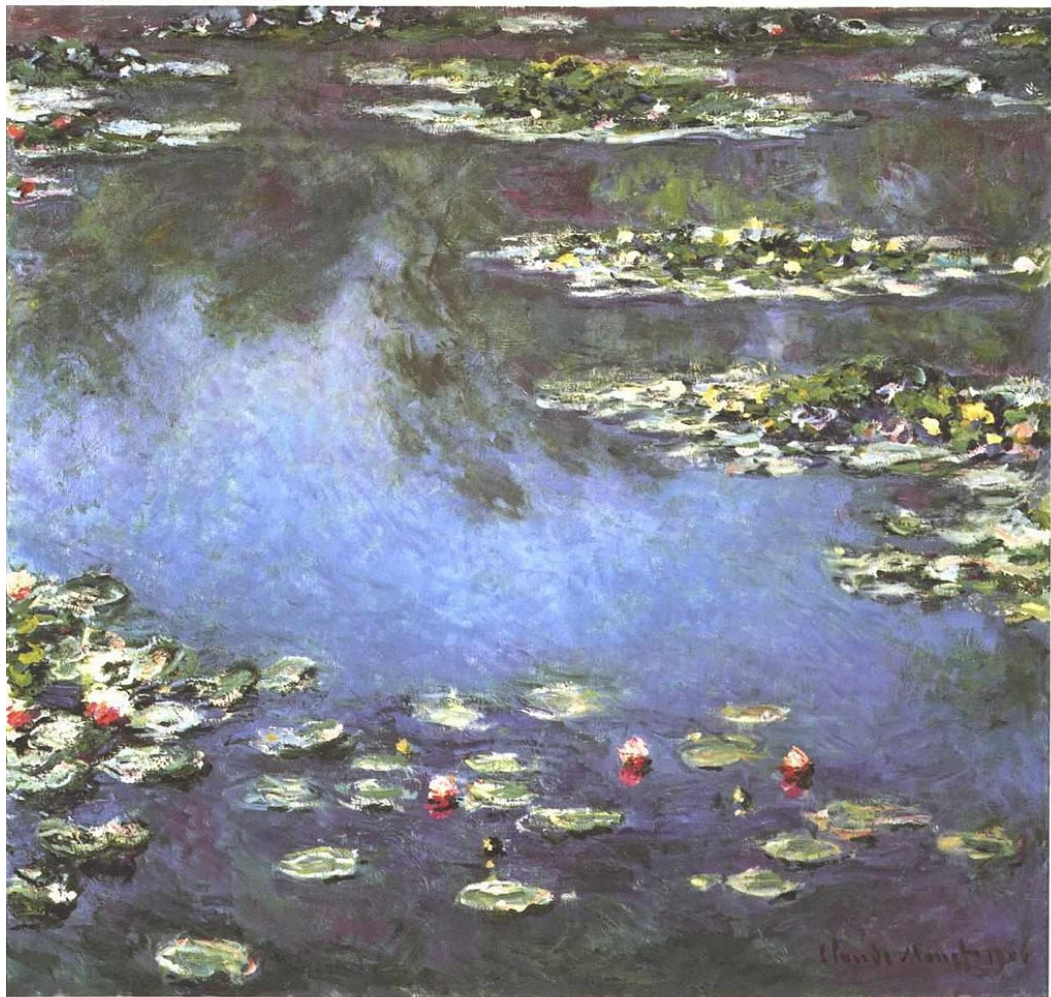
Next slide: *Water Lilies*, 1906

Imaginative Spanish painter

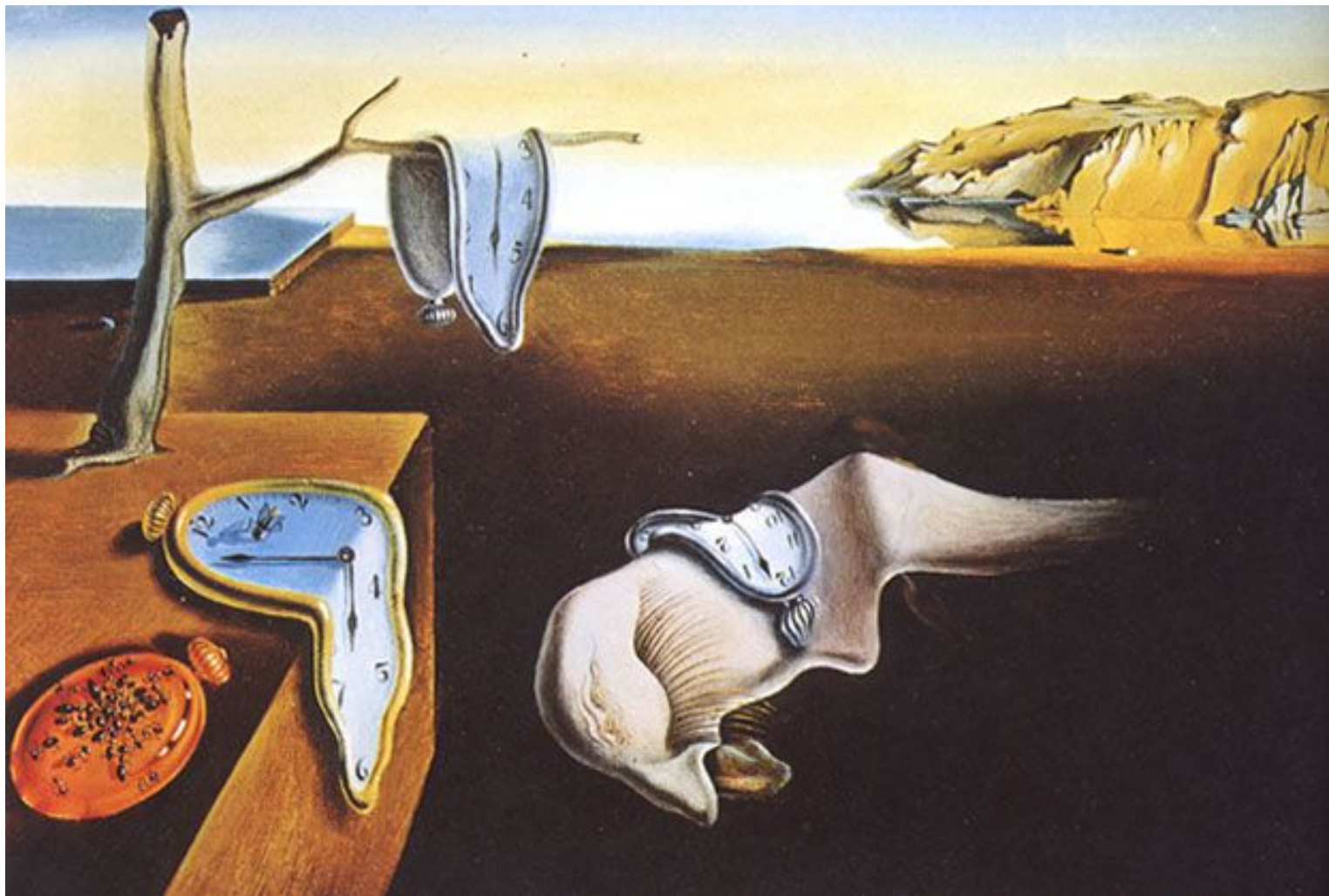
